

# Bahaia's Dance Camp Packing List

## Toiletries:

- Soap, Shampoo, Toothpaste, Etc...
- Sun Screen
- Insect Repellent
- Hair dryer
- Ear Plugs
- Allergy medications

## Linens:

- Sleeping Bag or bedding for twin size bunk
- Pillow
- 2 pillow cases (so you can use your pillow as a cushion at the shows)
- Beach Towel, Bath Towels, Wash Cloths

Note: Be prepared for nights in the 40's, sleeping bags should be rated for cold weather, heavy covers are suggested. The bunks may be lumpy and can be greatly improved with an egg-crate pad or similar.

## Clothing:

- Bathing suit and Water shoes
- Sport Sandals or Athletic Shoes
- WARM Pajamas
- Bathrobe
- Slippers that you don't mind getting wet/dirty (the grass is dewy)
- Cool and casual clothing for everyday wear: shorts, t-shirts, etc...
- Light jacket or shawl (for evening)
- Something fun for the evening shows (if you wish)

## For Class:

- Dance/Exercise attire for 3 days of class
- Dance slippers/shoes – the dance hall floor is not perfectly smooth or spotless
- Veil
- Finger Cymbals

## For Performance:

All campers are encouraged to perform in this very supportive environment. Be as casual or as creative as you wish. Sign up the first day at check-in.

- Costume & Cover-up
- Music – CD Only, 7 min max, no other music on the CD

## Utility Items:

- Flash light, extra batteries
- Folding chair
- Alarm clock with batteries
- Personal fan
- Portable Stereo w/ headphones
- Extension cord
- Clothes pins
- Hat
- Camera
- Sewing Kit

## Food & Beverage:

- Refillable Bottle for water or Bottled Water (The water from the tap/hose tastes just fine, but if you require bottled water, please bring your own)
- Small cooler for personal items (ice is available in the kitchen, BYOB alcohol is permitted but not provided, coolers can be safely left on your cabin porch, please no food in the cabins)
